Minutes of the Regular Monthly Meeting
Monday, January 12, 2026

The regular monthly meeting of the Town board of the Town of Norwood was called to order by Chairman Wilhelm at 6:30 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes of the December 2025 meeting were reviewed. Motion by Klimoski to accept the minutes, second by Royce. All in favor. Minutes accepted.

Financial report was read by the Clerk. Motion by Royce to accept the financial report, second by Klimoski. All in favor. Financial Report accepted.

Fire Department / Ambulance: Wilhelm proposed that we get a dumpster and clean out some of the old unused items in the Fire Department. Waldvogel commented that some of the items can be donated. Waldvogel and Bula will coordinate the cleaning of the Fire Department.

Zoning: Tautges requested zone change from AFR to residential for his lot on County Rd W. Royce made a motion to approve the zone change from AFR to residential, second by Klimoski. All in favor. Motion Carried.

Chrudimsky requested a zone change from farmland to residential on North Rollwood Rd. Klimoski made a motion to approve the zone change from farmland to residential, second by Royce. All in favor. Motion Carried.

Moose Lake Property: Klimoski reported on the meetings with the finance committee and County Board that he attended. They agreed on a 10 year lease for the Town of Norwood and Friends of Moose Lake to keep up the property as a park. Friends of Moose Lake would be willing to continue the upkeep of the property, cleaning trails, etc. Wilhelm report that there would be grant money available to apply for to assist in the improvements of the park. The town and Friends of Moose Lake will come up with an agreement for the maintenance of such park.

Evergreen Road Project: MSA would help write a grant for funding the Evergreen Road project. There is a cost of \$4,000 for MSA to research and write the grant. When and if the grant is received the towns portion of the project would be around \$76,077. Klimoski made a motion to sign the agreement to have MSA write the grant, second by Royce. All in Favor. Motion Carried. Agreement was signed and will be forwarded to MSA by the Clerk.

Old Business: Nothing.

Public Comment: Kuhr mentioned that customers were coming in the store complaining about the noise on the pond from loud snowmobiles.

Review and Pay Bills

Motion by Royce to adjourn the meeting at 7:05 p.m., second by Klimoski. Meeting adjourned.
